Guest Privacy Notice

1 INTRODUCTION

CER Heyday Management Limited ("**Heyday**", "**us**", "**we**" or "**our**") is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Notice sets out how any personal data which we collect about you will be processed by us as data controller, including your rights with respect to that processing.

2 PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

What personal data do we collect about you?

We collect the following categories of personal data about you when you apply for a room in our residence:

- Name
- ID/Passport
- Fmail
- Address
- Phone number

We also collect video images and static pictures of you through our use of CCTV systems in the Heyday premises and its immediate vicinity ("**Premises**"); which we highlight to you through appropriate CCTV signage in the Premises.

Transfers

We do not transfer your personal data outside of the EU.

Why do we collect your personal data?

We rely on different legal bases to process your personal data. For each legal basis set out below, we have set out the purpose for each processing operation and the categories of personal data which is processed in respect of same:

a. Performance of a Contract

How long do we retain your personal data for?

We will keep your personal data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected as described above and in accordance with our legal and regulatory obligations. This may mean that some information is held for longer than other information.

We keep your personal data for 7 years after you leave Heyday accommodation. To determine this retention period for personal data, we considered:

- The amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data and why it is collected and processed; and
- Applicable legal requirements. For example, we keep relevant personal data where it is necessary for reasons related to a legal claim or complaint, such as where we are subject to an investigation by a regulatory authority or where we are engaged in legal proceedings with respect to a claim related to your personal data or a claim brought by you.

In some circumstances, we may anonymise your personal data so that it can no longer be associated with you, in which case we may use such information without further notice to you.

3 YOUR RIGHTS

You have several rights in relation to your personal data, which may be subject to certain limitations and restrictions. These rights include to:

- have access to a copy of your personal data, and to be informed about the processing of that personal data (i.e. for what purposes, what types, to what recipients it is disclosed, storage periods, any third-party sources from where it was obtained);
- have us correct any inaccurate personal data about you and complete any personal data that is incomplete;
- request the erasure of your personal data;
- request a restriction on the processing of your personal data;
- object to the processing of your personal data on the basis that we are processing it in reliance on our legitimate interests (see Section 2 above). In such a case, we will stop processing your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds which override your interests and you have a right to request information on the balancing test we have carried out; and
- lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority using the contact details provided in Section 6 below.

We do not conduct any automated decision making and/ or profiling with respect to your personal data.

If you wish to exercise any of these rights, please contact us (see Section 6 below). We may request proof of identification to verify your request. We will endeavour to respond within a reasonable period and in any event within one month in compliance with applicable data protection law.

We aim to ensure that the information we hold about you is accurate at all times. To assist us in ensuring that your information is up to date, do let us know if any of your personal details change using the contact details set out in Section 6 below.

4 YOUR RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT WITH A SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy you might have, you have the right to lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority (e.g. the Office of the Data Protection Commissioner in Ireland (the, "**DPC**")) if you consider that we have infringed applicable data protection legislation when processing your personal data.

If at any time we decide to use personal data in a manner materially different from that stated in this Privacy Notice, or otherwise disclosed to you at the time it was collected, we will notify you in writing, and you will have a choice as to whether or not we use your personal data in the new manner in accordance with your rights under data protection law.
